We have completed our 2020 commercial corn and soybeans planting.

Start planting date: April 20th
19th
End planting date: May 2nd

2019
Start planting date: April
End planting date: June 10th

We are still planting seed corn fields which require multiple planting dates in one field. Planting season was much more timely this year compare to last year and weather permitting we will be completed shortly.
